

## The Club

The Idaho Gold Wrestling Club is a club designed for both beginning and advanced wrestlers. The club is operated out of the wrestling room at Columbia High School and has a primary purpose for developing future wrestlers for Columbia. With that being said, wrestlers from the valley are more than welcome to become part of the club and wrestle as a member of Idaho Gold.



Coaching for Idaho Gold is done on a volunteer basis. Club coaches are not paid and are donating their time in order to teach life skills. charac-

ter development, as well as provide a positive experience through the sport of wrestling. Coaches will be community members, high school coaches, as well as parents with or without wrestling experience.

Finally, national caliber tournaments will also be options for wrestlers wanting to test their metal against elite wrestlers from around the United States.
